3. Depict the date on which Mexicans celebrate their independence every year (include both month and day)	
4. What happens to someone when they think that Mexican Independence Day is celebrated on Cinco de Mayo	
5. "¡Viva Mexico!"	
6. A re-enactment of the Spanish people after losing the war in 1821	
7. Baile folklórico	
8. Fireworks ( <b>you can NOT actually set anything on fire!</b> )	
9. Sombreros	
10. A map or visual of Mexico, with Mexico City marked
