Geography:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Piedmonts = high land near the mountains</li> <li>- Swampland = wetlands</li> <li>- Fertile soil due to being close to Mississippi river</li> <li>- Climate: Sunny, warm &amp; wet</li> <li>- Everglades = protected swampland in Florida</li> </ul>	<p><b>S.E. History:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1500's Native Americans in S.E. first</li> <li>- Explorers from Spain, France, England &amp; Holland settled in S.E. in 1600's</li> <li>- North vs. South - North against slavery, south was for slavery (cash crops)</li> <li>- Civil War 1861 - 1865</li> <li>- Slavery abolished! (YAY ABE!)</li> </ul>
<p><b>S.E. Port Cities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Baltimore, Maryland</li> <li>- Charleston, South Carolina</li> <li>- Savannah, Georgia</li> <li>- Miami, Florida</li> <li>- New Orleans, Louisiana</li> <li>- Ships can import/export materials</li> <li>- Import (They made it and shipped to us)</li> <li>- Export (we made it and ship it out)</li> <li>- Import examples: electronics and cars from Japan</li> <li>- Export examples: Crops and fish</li> </ul>	<p><b>S.E. Today:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 3 groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Atlantic Coast States</li> <li>- Gulf Coast States</li> <li>- Inland South States</li> </ul> </li> <li>- 2 groups near water, and 1 group inland</li> <li>- MAIN INDUSTRY: Tourism! (People travel there)</li> <li>- Other industries: food processing, shipping, fishing, and farming</li> </ul>

<p><b>S.E. Geography:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Peninsula = land almost completely surrounded by water (Florida!)</li> <li>- Wetland/Swamplands = low land partially covered in water (Everglades)</li> <li>- Piedmont = high land near mountains</li> <li>- Mississippi River = makes land fertile = lots of crops!</li> <li>- Climate = warm, sunny, &amp; wet</li> </ul>	<p><b>S.E. History:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1500's Native Americans first people living in S.E.</li> <li>- 1600's, explorers from England, France, &amp; Spain settle in S.E.</li> <li>- 1700's/1800's divide between North &amp; South (North were against slavery, south were for slavery = cash crops!)</li> <li>- Abe Lincoln comes into office</li> <li>- Civil War 1861 - 1865</li> <li>- End of war in 1865, slavery was abolished!</li> </ul>

Port Cities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ex. of port cities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Baltimore, Maryland</li> <li>- Charleston, South Carolina</li> <li>- Savannah, Georgia</li> <li>- New Orleans, Louisiana</li> <li>- Miami, Florida</li> </ul> </li> <li>- import: products that are made in another country and come IN to our country</li> <li>- export: we make it and we ship it out</li> <li>- import ex: clothing &amp; electronics from Japan, fruits from Central America</li> <li>- export ex: crops and fruits and fish</li> </ul>	<p><b>S.E. Today:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 3 groups of states: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Atlantic Coast States</li> <li>- Gulf Coast States</li> <li>- Inland South States</li> </ul> </li> <li>- MAIN INDUSTRY = TOURISM!
