Project options. Circle the project you are most interested in.

1. Create your own precept - Poster:

- a. Review all of the precepts mailed into Mr. Browne at the end of the book.
- b. Then, write your own precept! Remember, a precept is saying that is **true**, sort of like a life motto to live by. What would your precept be?
- c. Create a poster with your personal precept and illustrate it. You must also write a paragraph explaining what the precept means to you.

2. Creative Writing:

- a. Choose a character from the book that does **not** have a part written by them (Mr. Tushman, Daisy, Mom, Dad, Christopher, Julian, Amos, Mr. Browne, etc.).
- b. Write a chapter that could be placed in the book Wonder written from this character's perspective. (Can be formatted however you'd like.)
- c. Must be typed. Minimum of 3 paragraphs.

3. Favorite Part - Diorama:

- a. Think about what your favorite part of this book was.
- b. Create a **3-D diorama** of this scene in the book.
- c. Then, write a short summary (at least 2 paragraphs) explaining what happened in that part, **and** why it's your favorite part.

4. Research - PowerPoint:

- a. Spend some time researching **craniofacial deformities** online.
- b. Create a PowerPoint presentation on Google Slides to explain the research you found about this disease.
- c. Must have at least 6 slides, including a **Works Cited** slide with a credible source.

5. Timeline of Events – Poster:

- a. Think back through the events of this novel. The plot follows August though an entire year of school. What big events made his 5th grade year memorable?
- b. Create and illustrate a timeline of Auggie's 5th grade year, as we read about it in the book. Must have at least 8 major events listed and written about in detail. Illustrations and color are required.
